Hellyer Velodrome Motor Pacing Guidelines

- 1. Motor pacing can only be done at scheduled events (any scheduled event where motor pacing is listed on calendar) and with approval of the session supervisor.
- 2. Reservations will be accepted for motor pace sessions. People with reservations have priority.
- Motor pace sessions are for Cat 1/2/3 riders (both road and track). Other
 Category riders can motor pace A) as space permits, B) if they have previous
 motor pacing experience, or C) with the permission of the driver and session
 supervisor.
- 4. Riders are responsible for providing their own motor and driver. The Northern California Velodrome Association only provides the availability to use the track.
- 5. Motor driver must have valid vehicle registration, motorcycle license and insurance. The motor driver must wear a DOT approved motorcycle helmet while on the track.
- 6. A copy of all required papers (current registration, insurance, and driver's license for class M) must be current and available upon request by the session supervisor.
- 7. Motor pace drivers shall maintain safe and prudent speeds at all times while on the track.
- 8. If a question of safety arises, the most conservative approach between the driver and the session supervisor will apply.
- 9. There will be a limit of two motors on the track at any one time.
- 10. The track supervisor is responsible for maintaining safety at all times. The track supervisor has the right to remove anyone from the track during motor pace sessions if the supervisor feels there is a potential safety problem.
